No One Leaves the Same

Spending a summer serving the Lord as a camp counselor can be one of the most spiritually rewarding and educational experiences of your life; it could also be one of the most challenging. Counselors are with their campers all day and all night. They are surrogate parents for five days, not to one camper, but as many as ten, and sometimes those campers can be a handful. It is the intimacy of sharing a cabin, eating, playing, singing, and living together that makes it possible to bridge the gap from your world to theirs, so that you can impact their lives.

At New Life Island our counselors are very important people. We have special speakers each week at camp and our campers sit under some great teaching, but it is the counselor who builds the one on one relationship which so often leads to a camper's decision. To have a quality camping program we need a quality counseling staff. That is why we search and pray for those special people that God brings to us each summer.

Our camp week starts Sunday evening with a staff meeting on Sunday evening and ends Saturday morning when our campers head for home. In between are five exciting days of games, swimming, campfires, Bible studies and many other activities that we want everyone to enjoy, because every camper wants a counselor who will enjoy camp right along with him.

Our counselor training will begin on Monday, June 21 and go until Friday, July 2. During these two weeks we will have sessions covering everything from belaying to praying. We will teach you everything you need to know to be a successful camp counselor. The season ends for our counselors on Saturday, August 7, after seven terrific weeks of serving the Lord together and seeing Him work in our lives and in the lives of our campers.

Financially we can offer our counselors \$1200.00 for the summer. The camp will cover the cost of First-Aid and CPR training and each staffer receives a staff shirt and other goodies. We ask our counselors to help raise support to cover the cost of their training. The details of this program will be provided when you become part of the team.

If you are chosen to become a camp counselor you can be sure that you will be stretched, tested, tired out, pushed, and encouraged in an experience that will change your life forever. That is why at New Life Island we say, "No one leaves the same".

The following is an abbreviated doctrinal statement for New Life Island, which is a ministry of the Garden State Fellowship of Regular Baptist Churches. A more detailed statement may be obtained from the camp.

We Believe...

-- **The Bible** to be the authoritative, inerrant, only inspired Word of God to man, relevant to all our needs, and is to be the divine standard for faith and conduct.

--**The God of the Bible** is the only One Sovereign, eternally self-existent God, subsisting as three co-equal Persons (Father, Son, & Spirit), yet one unified God, undivided and indivisible.

--**Jesus** is the only eternally, preexistent, Son of God: Virgin conceived and born as the only sinless God-man and Savior of the world; Who died for us, and rose again the third day, and has ascended back to heaven.

--**The Holy Spirit** is God, with all of the same personalities and attributes as God the Father and the Son, and is sent by the same to reveal God's word to us (by inspiration and illumination), to convict us of sin, and to bring us to faith in Christ, baptizing us into Christ's body, and indwelling (forever on earth) the believer, filling us as we surrender to Him. The gifts called "sign gifts" have ceased and are not for today.

--**The Literal Six Day Creation** account as recorded in Genesis, and that God, as Creator, is responsible for all life (plant, animal, human, angelic), and that all life is responsible to God, and that He alone is the giver, taker, and sustainer of all life.

--**In Sin** as the violation of God's will, and the intruder into God's creation, which is punishable by death (both physical and spiritual). It was first discovered in Lucifer (the Devil), then the fallen angels (the demons), and then in man in the transgression of Adam and Eve, and has since been imputed, by both character and penalty, to the entire human race (inherited sin), leaving all mankind totally depraved in sin.

--**Salvation** to be the gracious act of God, whereby He delivers undeserving gospel believing sinners from their inherited sin with its penalty, according to their faith in the substitutionary atonement of Christ alone for their sin. They are then granted a new life in Christ, justified by His blood, declared to be saints, freed from the slavery to sin, and are given an eternal inheritance in heaven.

--**The Church** to be the universal Body of Christ (all genuinely saved people) which began with the baptism of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost in Acts 2, and concludes with the pre-tribulational rapture of the church. The Church is to manifest itself on earth, and operate through local churches whose ministry is to carry on the work of Christ by evangelism, discipleship, believer's water baptism, worship (including communion) and edification of the saints, and it is to be organized with pastors and deacons.

--**In the Judgments** of God upon both the saved and the unsaved. The saved believer's works are judged, upon the bodily resurrection (rapture) of the church to Heaven, and at the Judgment seat of Christ, for the purpose of determining rewards in Heaven. The unsaved will be judged by God for their unforgiven sin, as well as actual sins, and will be delivered to the Lake of Fire (Hell) for all eternity.
